



Golf Cart Operating Regulations

All park visitors who wish to bring a personal golf cart to Johnson County Park must complete this application annually. A fee of \$5 per cart is required. A non-transferable permit sticker will be issued to you upon approval of this application, and must be displayed on the front driver's side of your cart's body.

Carts must affix the issued permit sticker to the front driver's side and ensure it is conspicuously displayed.

Cart operators must comply with all traffic regulations and speed limits. Carts without headlights are not permitted to operate after dark.



ALL operators must have a valid driver's license and must have it with them while operating the cart.

Carts are only permitted on paved/gravel roadways and should not cut across fields, especially ditches, outside of the campground. At no time are carts allowed in the amphitheatre or on the golf course.

Carts are only permitted on the cross country course by permission of park management for a specific event.

Open display or use of alcohol on golf carts is not allowed.

Carts may not carry more than the number of passengers for which they were designed.

Some park events may not permit entry by golf cart. Please be aware of the designations for each event.

Carts used in a reckless manner or violating park cart regulations will be penalized:

1st Violation—Verbal Warning

2nd Violation—Suspension of golf cart privileges for the remainder of your visit.

3rd Violation—Suspension of golf cart privileges indefinitely.

FAQs

If I am only coming to stay for one night, do I still need a permit?

Yes. All carts on park property will need a permit if they are going to be operated outside of the Hoosier Horse Park.

What types of carts are allowed?

Gas/electric golf carts with stock engines. E-Z Go, Club, and Yamaha carts are allowed. Engines may not exceed 14 HP. Stock mufflers or equivalent are required.

So I can't bring my...

ATVs, ORVs, RUVs, dirt bikes, go carts, or dune buggies. If you are uncertain, please check with the park office.

I saw these Horse Park people with four wheelers. Why can't I bring mine?

The HHP allows use of these type of vehicles as long as they do not leave the confines of the HHP. If you see these type of vehicles outside of the HHP, please contact the park office.

How long is the permit good for?

Through the end of the year.

I can let my 14 year old drive, right?

No, you must only have licensed drivers operating your cart at any time. While we know this is a difficult policy, it must be recognized.
